

ARTIST RULES

1. Artists MUST be present for the duration of the show: 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., on Saturday, November 19 and 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday, November 20, 2022. Work must be exhibited both days — no exceptions.
2. All exhibits must be original work done by the exhibiting artists and offered for sale. Application for works of a collaborative nature must include all artists' names.
3. No dealers, agents, stand-ins or proxies allowed.
4. Only work representative of the artists' slides will be permitted. If exhibited works differ significantly from the images submitted, the artist may be asked to leave and will forfeit fees.
5. Buy/sell or imports will not be tolerated.
6. Artists will be notified by email of their assigned booth number and location, along with exhibitor information about check-in, set-up and parking, no later than August 19, 2022. All booth requests will be considered, but accommodation is not guaranteed.
7. All work and artist belongings, including chairs, must be contained within the assigned booth space. Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their area clean during and after the show. Belongings cannot be stored along the walls or patios of local businesses.
8. The festival is completely outdoors. The festival organizers and participants accept the risk that poor weather may occur. No partial refunds will be granted due to postponement or early closure due to rain/weather.
9. Artists are required to display the official card bearing their name, space number and city residence for the duration of the Festival.
10. Each artist is responsible for collecting and reporting Florida sales tax on all sales made during the Festival.
11. Parking and traffic are not permitted in show area after 9:00 a.m. on Saturday. The streets will remain closed on Saturday night and security will be on site. Although artists, at their discretion, will be allowed to leave exhibitor displays on the street overnight on Saturday, the City of Gainesville is not liable for any loss and/or damage.
12. Artists may drive onto the festival streets after 5:30 pm both Saturday and Sunday (no vehicles are allowed before this time) by showing their festival pass to the officer. The streets will reopen to the public at 8:00 p.m. on Sunday evening, and all booths must be dismantled and removed by this time.

All rules will be strictly enforced. Failure to follow these rules will result in ineligibility for this and future shows and any prize award.
